If you want to try something different – that is great fun with celebrities, delicious food and big prizes – the Lions' Tony Filippis Memorial Bocce Tournament is just the ticket!

The event is named in honor of the late Tony Filippis, a wonderful man and a powerful advocate for the disabled community who passed away earlier this year.

Lions' "Bocce Day" is May 16<sup>th</sup> at the beautiful Palazzo di Bocce in Orion Township, just north of the Palace of Auburn Hills. Palazzo di Bocce is one of the nation's newest and finest bocce ball facilities. It features 10 indoor championship courts in a 32,000 square foot facility that includes a pro shop, spectator seating and a restaurant that serves outstanding Italian cuisine.

Targeted for novice and accomplished bocce players alike, sponsorships range from individual tickets at \$150 to banners at \$1,000 to team sponsorships at \$2,500 to \$10,000. Annually, 400-500 persons attend the event.
