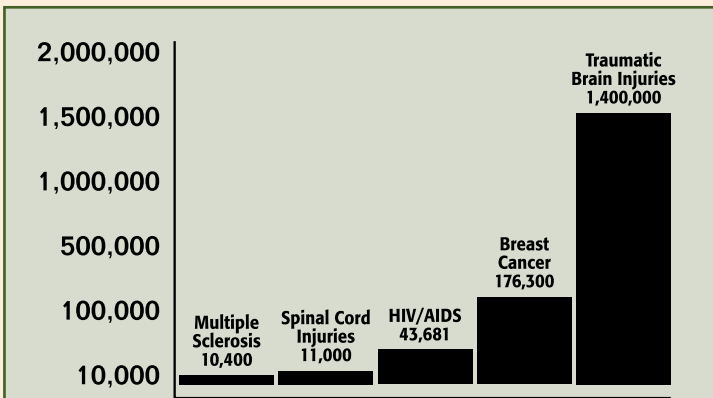

- An estimated 5.3 million Americans – a little more than 2 percent of the U.S. population – currently live with disabilities resulting from traumatic brain injury (TBI)
- 1.4 million Americans sustain a traumatic brain injury each year.
- More than 50,000 people die every year as a result of TBI.
- TBI is the leading cause of death and disability among youth and young adults.
