

The home features 3 bedrooms, and 2 full baths plus kitchen/living room and first floor laundry. The Madicks have also added a greenhouse addition to the rear of the home. There is a propane furnace w/wood burning add-on to heat the home plus an outdoor wood burner. The homestead has a large fenced garden area with strawberries, blackberries, red raspberries, and asparagus. There are also apple and peach trees as part of this self-sustaining farm.
