The vehicle number HAN8L60097 matches the data plate under the hood., Mileage showing on the odometer indicates 102,850. The title lists 2,784 & calls out "Non actual warning: Odometer Discrepancy.", The following notes are from the owner's record dated 18 NOV 10., FEATURES & MODIFICATIONS (as described by previous owner):, 1. 1965 - 1966 MKIII chassis, 2. 1/4 elliptical rear springs, 3. For 1968, Dodge installed more V-8 engines than sixcylinders in light trucks, as buyers rallied around haulers and demanded the spirited performance they were accustomed to in cars. The 1968 model trucks received a new grille that fully surrounded the headlamps and the round front marker lamps were gone -- replaced by vertical, rectangular lamps.
