Roland Donovan Osborne, (RD Osborne), artist, Union Township, Miami County, West Milton, OH (1904-1977). Ohio & Indiana landscape, portrait & still life artist who taught at Indiana University & Earlham College, with works exhibited around the world, including the national museum collection of Moscow.

Clarence Klatt, (C Klatt), Bethel Township, Clark County, New Carlisle, OH, 20<sup>th</sup> Century artist in the post impressionistic manner. He was a third generation of a local blacksmith family who painted at an early age and through a scholarship was able to study at the Dayton Art Institute. He affixed the "Klatt's Blacksmith & Welding Shop, ¼ mile north of New Carlisle" label to many of his works which he displayed locally & along highway Rt 69, now Rt 235. Most are framed, but there are others.
