# INFORMATION REGARDING THE REAL ESTATE SELLER DISCLOSURE LAW

Generally speaking, the Real Estate Seller Disclosure Law (68 P.S. §7301 et seq.) requires that before an agreement of sale is signed, the seller in a residential real estate transfer must make certain disclosures regarding the property to potential buyers in a form defined by the law. - 10. Transfers of new construction that has never been occupied when:
  - a. The buyer has received a one-year warranty covering the construction;
  - b. The building has been inspected for compliance with the applicable building code or, if none, a nationally recognized model building code; and
  - c. A certificate of occupancy or a certificate of code compliance has been issued for the dwelling.

In addition to these exceptions, disclosures for condominiums and cooperatives are limited to the seller's particular unit(s). Disclosures regarding common areas or facilities are not required, as those elements are already addressed in the laws that govern the resale of condominium and cooperative interests.

While the Law requires certain disclosures, this statement includes disclosures beyond the basic requirements of the Law in an effort to assist sellers in complying with seller disclosure requirements and to assist buyers in evaluating the property being considered.
